## Using Expanded Noun Phrases

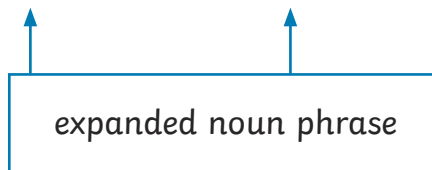
An expanded noun phrase is a phrase made up of a noun and at least one adjective. We can add them to sentences to make them more descriptive.

Here is a simple sentence: There are trees in the park.

We can add adjectives before one of the nouns so that it becomes:



There are **huge, towering trees** in the park.



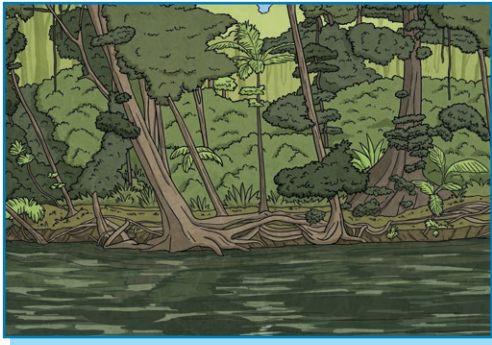
